

### StarLaunch

The module for the intercepting data and initiating tasks, StarLaunch initiates and performs this function by executing a program or a script depending on the intercepted files name, type, extension or contents.

In addition to managing program call-ups, the StarLaunch module also manages requests for printing and printers. A single access point can be used to control and secure access to all network printers, local or remote.

The highly evolved graphic interface can provide an overview of all activities, or a filtered view of specific print requests. It also authorizes secure access to be able to control printers.

- Graphical representation of printer status (Waiting, Online, Offline, Printing...)
